The Assembly Elections of 2026 in West Bengal and Tamil Nadu marked a significant turning point in Indian politics and attracted nationwide attention due to their unexpected outcomes and larger political implications. These elections were more than just regional contests; they reflected the changing priorities of Indian voters and highlighted the growing importance of governance, accountability, development, and leadership in modern politics. CONCERNS RISE OVER HIGH WATER CONSUMPTION IN ETHANOL PRODUCTION



A recent report has ignited a fresh debate over the sustainability of ethanol production in India. The claim that producing just one litre of ethanol may require as much as 10,000 litres of water has raised serious concerns about the environmental cost of the country's aggressive push toward biofuels. Ethanol, a renewable fuel typically produced from sugarcane, maize, or other biomass, has been a central part of India's strategy to reduce dependence on fossil fuels and cut carbon emissions. The government has actively promoted ethanol blending in petrol, aiming to achieve higher blending targets in the coming years. While the initiative is seen as a step toward cleaner energy, the reported water footprint has prompted questions about its long-term viability. 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US REJECTS IRAN'S MISSILE STRIKE CLAIMS IN STRAIT OF HORMUZ TENSIONS
